



From our Community Lay Director


Hello Emmaus Community,

From our Community **Spiritual Director**

Recently, I was reading a publication from 'Australian Christian Lobby' It read "When a nation sins, it will have one ruler after another. But with a man of wisdom and understanding, its stability will long continue." (Prov 28:2)

Contemplating its startling contemporary relevance, (in regard to our political scene) - a verse like this reminds me

of a truth I discovered some years ago.

It is this: scripture contains the first principles of everything we need to know for life in this world.

We need to seek the principles of life with discernment and use the knowledge to move forward in grace, in everything we do.

I believe the words of Proverbs 28 bring a great starting place to be seeking where God would want each of us to be as part of this Emmaus Community; what we do in love with God's help and guidance of His Word should assist us each to make positive decisions on how we answer His call on our lives to serve... whether this is through our local church encouraging others to walk the 'Road to Emmaus'; or answering the call to participate faithfully as part of a team for a Walk; or perhaps God is calling you to a new position on the Board of our community.

Here are just a few of my thoughts in seeking God's Word through Proverbs 28.



The wicked flee though no one pursues, but the righteous are as bold 1 as a lion. (I encourage you to be bold for the Lord.)

Those who forsake instruction praise the wicked, but those who heed it 4 resist them. (As part of a team we learn discipline.)

A discerning son heeds instruction, but a companion of gluttons 7 disgraces his father. (Listen to God and heed His Word.)

If anyone turns a deaf ear to my instruction, even their prayers are 9 detestable. (Again listen to God and be humble.)

Whoever leads the upright along an evil path will fall into their own 10 trap, but the blameless will receive a good inheritance. (Be aware that in all our preparations to be honest)

The rich are wise in their own eyes; one who is poor and discerning sees 11 how deluded they are. (Ensure that as you look forward you are wise and not fooled by your own eyes)

Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who 13 confesses and renounces them finds mercy. (Take time to be in a reunion group where one can be openly confessing.)

A faithful person will be richly blessed, but one eager to get rich will 20 not go unpunished. (Seek to be faithful in your actions.)


Those who trust in themselves are fools, but those who walk in wisdom 26 are kept safe. (Trust in God's Word in all you do.)

held at the Grace Lutheran College, Caboolture. Over the Training Weekend the team will have the opportunity to critique the talks that will be given at the Walk. I am looking forward to us coming together over this weekend for a time of Praise & Worship and Fellowship.

On Saturday evening 8 September 2018 will be the Brisbane North Coast Gathering that will be held at Morayfield Uniting Church. We would love for you attend as the Teams from both the Men's & Women's Walk will be commissioned and will give you the opportunity to meet the teams who answered God's call to be on Team.

The 72-hour Prayer vigils are up on the Website please sign up to pray over the team on their weekend. Remember back to your weekend when you found out that people had been praying for you and what a blessing it was.

Finally, the Theme for our Walk is "The Cracked Pot" and the story is as follows:

A Water Bearer in India had two large pots, each hung on each end of a pole which he carried across his neck. One of the pots had a crack in it, and while the other pot was perfect and always delivered a full portion of water at the end of the long walk from the stream to the master's house, the cracked pot arrived only half full. For a full two years this went on daily, with the bearer delivering only one and one-half pots of water in his master's house.

The perfect pot was proud of its accomplishments, perfect to the end for which it was made. But the poor cracked pot was ashamed of its own imperfection, and miserable that it was able to accomplish only half of what it had been made to do. After two years of what it perceived to be a bitter failure, it spoke to the Water Bearer one day by the stream. "I am ashamed of myself, and I want to apologize to you." "Why?" asked the bearer. "What are you ashamed of?" "I have been able, for these past two years, to deliver only half my load because this crack in my side causes water to leak out all the way back to your master's house. Because of my flaws, you have to do all of this work, and you don't get full value from your efforts," the pot said. The Water Bearer felt sorry for the old cracked pot, and in his compassion, he said, "As we return to the master's house, I want you to notice the beautiful flowers along the path." Indeed, as they went up the hill, the old cracked pot took notice of the sun warming the beautiful wild flowers on the side of the path, and this cheered it some. But at the end of the trail, it still felt bad because it had leaked out half its load, and so again it apologize to the bearer for its failure. The bearer said to the pot, "Did you notice that there were flowers only on your side of your path, but not on the other pot's side? That's because I have always known about your flaw, and I took advantage of it. I planted flower seeds on your side of the path, and every day while we walk back from the stream, you've watered them. For two years I have been able to pick these beautiful flowers to decorate my master's table. Without you being just the way, you are, he would not have this beauty to grace his house."

Each of us has our own unique flaws. We're all cracked pots. But if we will allow it, the Lord will use our flaws to grace His Father's table. In God's great economy, nothing goes to waste. So, as we seek ways to minister together, and as God calls you to tasks He has appointed for you, don't be afraid of your flaws. Acknowledge them, and allow Him to take advantage of them, and you, too, can be the cause of beauty in His pathway. Go out boldly, knowing that in our weakness we find His strength, and that "In Him every one of God's promises is a Yes."
