Hello Community,

I have good news and bad news this month. First the good news. We currently have 8 pilgrims registered for the upcoming Women's Walk. Please keep Leane and her team in your prayers as well as the pilgrims as they prepare for this Emmaus experience. On a sadder note, we have had to postpone the Men's Walk due to insufficient numbers. It is so disappointing for Paul and his team who were prepared and ready to go. We are planning on rescheduling the Men's walk to 14 – 17 March 2019 at Glendalough Outdoor Centre. I strongly encourage you to start thinking and praying about who you could sponsor for this walk now. Emmaus can only exist if we have pilgrims.

I mentioned last month, that we are currently restructuring our board. The aim of this restructure is to make our processes more efficient and reduce the time commitment required for support roles. We are conscious that Emmaus was designed to support our local churches. With this in mind we are hoping that this restructure enables people to develop their skills but also have the time to serve through their local churches. Under the new structure we will have a much smaller executive group that will meet regularly to ensure that we are running our Emmaus Ministries appropriately. We will then have people in support roles which will only be activated to help run an Emmaus Ministry such as an Emmaus Walk or Face to Face Encounter. Please contact me if you are interested in being involved or would like more information about the roles that are currently available.

Finally, as we have postponed the Men's Walk, there will be no Candlelighting service this weekend. Instead will we have our usual Gathering on Saturday at Morayfield Community Church starting at 5:30pm. I hope to see many of you then.

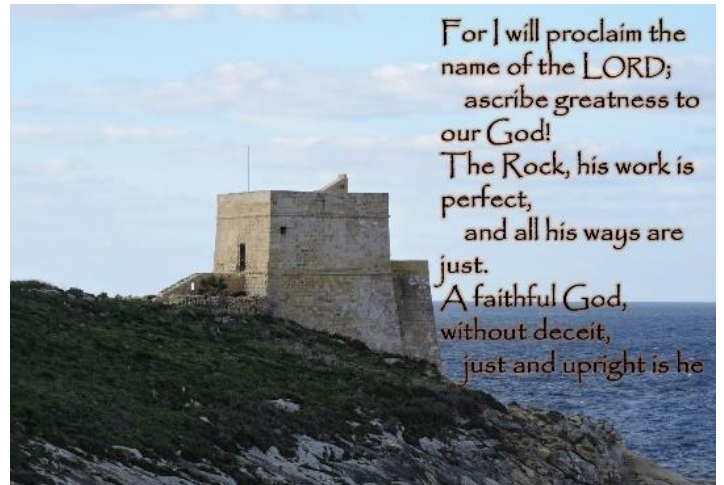
Here is the opportunity to get them registered now for the walk in March.

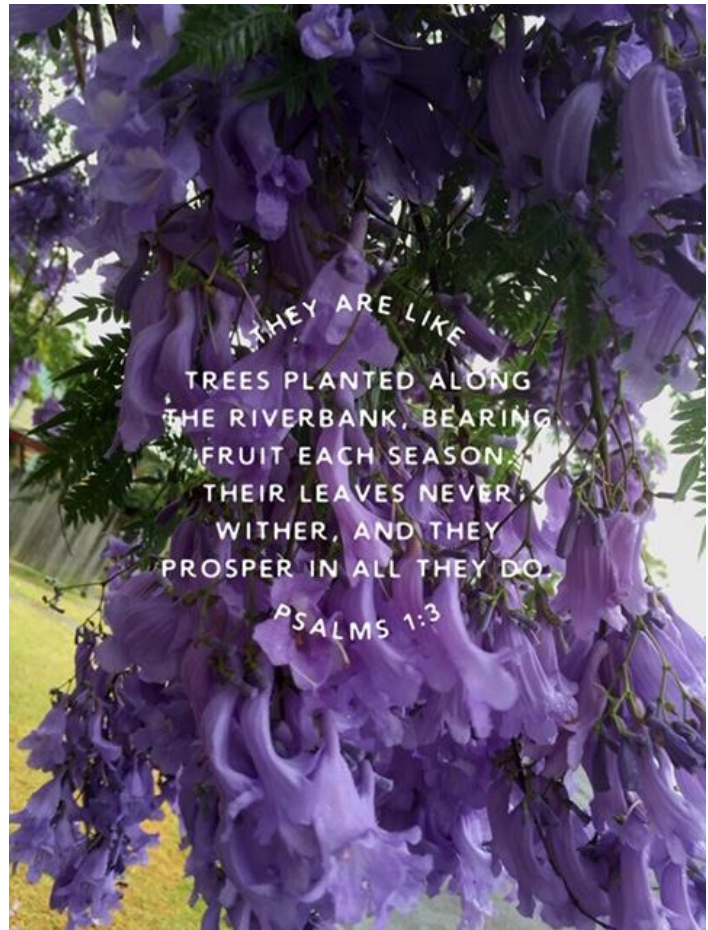

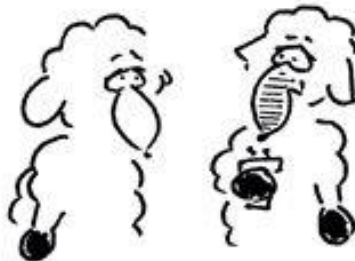

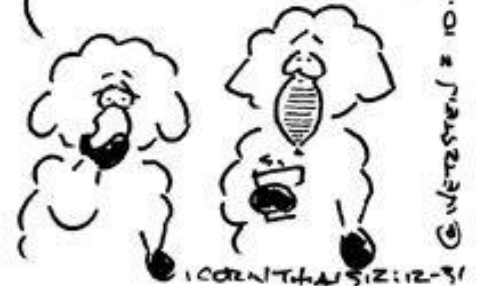
