From our Community Lay Director

Hasn't this month flown by quickly? It seems like yesterday I was writing my spiel for last month's newsletter.

Anyhow, may I encourage you to attend this month's Gathering at Morayfield Community Church as we commission the teams for Walks #99 and #100. These

team members have stepped up on behalf of the community to demonstrate God's love to the pilgrims of Walks #99 & #100. So I do ask that you try to find the time to come and support them at their commissioning. We will also be commissioning the team for the first Face To Face Encounter. This is an exciting new program developed by The Upper Room which we have the privilege of piloting in Australia. The Face to Face team would also love your support and encouragement as they take a step of faith and participate in this new venture.

Speaking about the Emmaus Walks, have you been praying about who you could sponsor? We cannot run walks without pilgrims. If you do not have anyone you can sponsor for these walks, maybe you could provide financial support to a pilgrim or team member. If you would like to contribute financially, please let the board or Lay Directors know. Alternatively, you can make a donation through the offering collected at the gatherings or electronically via direct debit into the Emmaus bank account.

I ask that you continue to pray for the Walks and the teams as they continue their preparations. Pray also for the Face To Face Encounter and its team as they commence their training.

The National Emmaus Conference will in Adelaide from 13 to 15 April 2018. Please pray for all involved as they meet to share experiences and discuss the Emmaus movement in Australia. The board will be spending time praying for this and our community this month before the gathering instead of having a board meeting. Prayer has always been the foundation of the Emmaus movement and we believe that prayer is vital to keeping our community vibrant.





From our Community Spiritual Director

To sanctify is <u>literally</u> "to set apart for special use or purpose," figuratively "to make holy or sacred," and <u>etymologically</u> from the <u>Latin verb</u> <u>sanctificare</u> which in turn is from <u>sanctus</u> "holy" and <u>facere</u> "to make."

Wow! Have you ever read the meaning of things you thought you knew, or thought that were too difficult to comprehend, I think sometimes we think we know and because of this we fail to do any follow through research on the subject. Now I think that this doesn't just hold for things of God in our life, but for any number of things; like baking and football opposite ends of the spectrum.

However, I am always looking up the meanings of words and new situations or cultures I come across in my readings, it is an interesting pastime, but as we come to these next Walks and as the teams train and work on all areas of the Walks, I thought it was a great topic to look at Sanctification. Sanctification is a biblical doctrine that is emphasized a great deal in Christian teaching. Yet despite its importance, it is often perceived as a religious notion too complex to comprehend. Though sanctification may at first seem to be a foreign concept, it is one of the greatest things that has and is happening to every believer in Jesus Christ. Sanctification plays a key role in a Christian's spiritual growth.

Sanctification comes from the verb sanctify. Sanctify originates from the Greek word hagiazo, which means to be "separate" or to be "set apart." In the Bible, sanctification generally relates to a sovereign act of God whereby He "sets apart" a person, place, or thing in order that His purposes may be accomplished. We read of many things set apart by God from Exodus, where God sanctifies a place of worship. "And there I will meet with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by My glory," Exodus 29:43. Even a day can be sanctified as seen in Genesis 2:3 where the seventh day is "set apart" as a holy day of rest. "Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made."

Similarly, when a person is sanctified he or she is being set apart by God for a specific divine purpose. This is where as an Emmaus Community when we Commission our Teams and Leaders we 'set them apart' for a divine purpose. Our work is of God; just as in the very moment we are saved in Christ we are

also immediately sanctified and begin the process of being conformed to the image of Christ. As God's children we are "set apart" from that moment to carry out His divine purposes unto eternity. Hebrews 10:14 says, "For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified."

To each one who has answered the call to be part of these Walks you have been 'set apart' by God for a divine purpose, to be the very best we can be for the Pilgrims who will come.

Please continue to pray for our teams and the leaders and for those pilgrims who will come. Pray for whom God is 'setting you apart to sponsor' and give the opportunity to know our God more.
