

# From our Community Spiritual Director

#### **Our Fourth Days and Next Days**

It's Easter Sunday night and I am reflecting on that night centuries ago as our risen Lord appears to his frightened and confused disciples. We can try to put ourselves in their sandals, but we can't really appreciate what they had been through and continue to struggle to understand! The word was out that Jesus' tomb was empty and some were saying he was risen from the dead!



Two thousand years later and WE continue to celebrate the

resurrection of Jesus on this third day. Recently we have watched Lee Strobel's movie, "The Case for Christ". After his careful research into the historic accuracy of the documents, the medical evidence and validity of the resurrection, he believed, and is now a pastor at the large church where it all happened. It's a worthwhile movie to watch!

Believing that Jesus rose from the dead makes all the difference to our fourth day. In his life, and death, he had shared our human struggles and pain, suffered a horrendous death but rose again! Jesus lives! death has lost its sting, and He will never leave us or abandon us. By his wounds we are healed. Through his death the veil that separated us from God has been torn and we can come near and talk with Jesus face to face just as Moses did.

Knowing the reality of that third day, the reality of the presence of the Risen Lord, makes all the difference to our fourth day! Why then do we sometimes ask Jesus to be present with us as we leave a meeting or leave home on a new morning? The Lord has promised that he is with us always and will NEVER leave us or forsake us. As a spiritual discipline try practising, until it becomes second nature, being aware of God's presence and saying, "Thank you Lord that you ARE with me as you promised. Remind me of your presence and jog my awareness so that I know that your Spirit is with me and lives within me. Remind me that I am in you and you are in me."

Praise God that our life in Christ is this ever-present relationship and reality. Pray more for awareness of the Spirit's presence in the everyday moments and hours of each day. May you become more and more aware of God's presence with you in your fourth day and next day as you trust in his amazing grace. This is the life in all its fullness that Jesus came to bring and in his presence there is fullness of joy.
