From our Community Spiritual Director

Clearing the way! Removing the Obstacles!

When I was asked to be an Assistant Spiritual Director at the next Women's Walk in August, I asked if I could do the *Obstacles to Grace* talk. I had not done that talk before, even though I have been a Spiritual Director on many walks. I wanted to get to the root of my

uneasiness about the talk's focus. There seemed to be something missing. It has been a challenge but a good one, as I have dug deep into obstacles to grace in my own life and how they can be overcome in a significant way.

From 2012 to 2015, I studied in the Spiritual Direction Formation Program at St. Francis College and was accredited in November 2015. While preparing my Obstacles to Grace Talk, I came across this quote:

"The ministry of spiritual direction specializes in **identifying things which hinder us from living in grace**, and discovering paths that allow us to **walk in the grace of being accepted, loved and free."**

I had one of those "aha" moments. Emmaus Walks focus on grace; Dying Moments communion gives pilgrims an opportunity through sharing in the bread and wine, to name their dying moment – to give up or die to their personal pain and brokenness, sin, a wrong attitude, habit, characteristic, or burden so that they can experience the resurrection power and life of Christ. The pieces seemed to fall in place for me.

The use of the term "spiritual director" in Emmaus is not accidental! The chapel visits in particular are designed to enable pilgrims to let go of all that hinders their relationship with God, others and themselves, and to be empowered to walk with a new freedom in Christ as loved, forgiven people.

A spiritual director is one who walks alongside us on our journey, who companions us, who accepts us warts and all, and loves us with God's love. There is no judgment but an unmasking of the obstacles that edge God out through the power of the Holy Spirit. As we recognise and name our sin, our failure, our shame - all those big rocks that stand in the way are removed and we find greater freedom. It's a continuing process as our brokenness is restored but we will never conquer the obstacles to God's grace in our lives by ourselves.

The purpose our monthly Gatherings and Reunion Groups is to support you, pilgrims on their Fourth Day or their Next Day. That is one key to overcoming the obstacles that hinder us in are

ongoing walk. It is the Holy Spirit who brings to light the obstacles and set us free but we also need each other. We are created for community, and we draw strength from one another as we share joys and burdens along life's journey.

Ongoing Spiritual Direction is a significant Means of Grace to keep us free and walking in fullness of life. The obstacles are always on our side because God longs for all of us to come home! I am happy to answer any questions you may have or talk with you about ongoing spiritual direction. God bless you on your continuing journey with Christ.

"Let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us (Hebrews 12:1).
