From our Community Spiritual Director

This month we have Men's Walk #103 and Women's Walk #104. It has been a busy few months as teams have been called together and trained for their roles. What a rich story the Community has woven over the years as people have experienced their own Walk to Emmaus and then often been invited back to serve on Team.

Every time I sing "Weave" I am reminded of that rich diversity of people and gifts which form our Brisbane North Coast Community and the joy of being part of this specific ministry.



The Emmaus movement exists to run the Walks, and our Gatherings support that ministry as we encourage the growth in leadership and renewal of leaders in their local churches.

What about your own story of your growth in Christ and your ongoing service to our Lord since your own Walk? There will be many other ways in which you have grown in your own church and through various study groups, reading, and conferences. How has your Emmaus and Encounter experience helped you to grow? How do you plant yourself in a place where optimum growth is assured?

Paul says to the Christians in Colossae, that he was thankful for their faith and for the good news of the gospel that was bearing fruit in their lives as they have come to understand the grace of God. He has heard of their faith he has not stopped praying for them.

On some of our Fourth Days and Next Days, we may feel thirsty and dried out like a withered leaf or plant. Sometimes we feel battered and fall over like a small plant knocked about by heavy rain or wind. Sometimes we are hungry for more of God.

Paul has some sound advice about how we can continue to grow in faith and strengthen our commitment as disciples.

"As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving." Colossians 2: 6

Just before I sat down at the computer to write this, I was watching "Gardening Australia". They often speak about the importance of good soil structure and organic matter which results in healthy flourishing plants, fruit and vegetables.


What does it mean to be firmly "Rooted in Christ"?

Paul says lives your lives in him [Christ] like a plant flourishing in good soil! We are to be firmly planted in Christ. Good soil is friable, well drained, with lots of nutrients and minerals which support strong roots and provide all that is needed for the plant to be healthy and fruitful. We are to live "in Christ" so that the support and nourishment that will make us strong, healthy and fruitful comes from him from day to day. We are to live in Christ and Christ in us! It's all about *relationship* – a recurring theme in several Emmaus talks. Christ is the substance and foundation of our Faith (Colossians 2: 17)

Australian trees of the outback survive in harsh conditions because they have long tap roots which reach down deep into the soil and rock to find the underground water. Let's learn from our harsh Australian landscape and reach down deeper into Christ as the source of our life. Take the healthy nourishment of the Means of Grace so that as you remain "rooted in Christ," you will remain strong in love, faith, in hope, in courage and in service.
