Hello everyone,

At the end of an Emmaus Ministry experience, participants are invited to reflect on two questions:

- 1. What has this experience meant to me?
- 2. What am I going to do about it?

I did my Emmaus walk 22 years ago. I was a tragically single, fiscally impaired, unemployed 23 year old who was trying to figure out what God had planned for my life after what I thought was Plan A fell apart. Through my Emmaus experience God showed me that he had lifted me out of the slimy pit of despair I was in and set my feet on solid ground. He placed a new song in my heart, a song of praise. He restored my creativity and he began the process of rebuilding my confidence and self-esteem.

To be honest, I found my Emmaus walk to be very overwhelming and it took me awhile after the walk to fully process what my Emmaus walk had meant to me and figure out what I was going to do about it. Since my Emmaus walk I have continued on my journey with God and he has led me down an amazing path. I am now married to a wonderful Christian man. I am Mum to 5 children and mother-in-law to another two. I have three grandchildren. I can tell you that my Plan A did not include having three grandkids by the time I was 40! I have a career in an industry I was adamant I would never work in. But one in which I am able to help people and share God's love. I have been in leadership roles within my church that I would never even have considered before I did Emmaus. My life has changed significantly over the last 22 years. But my Emmaus experience has helped equip me for the journey God is taking me on.

I would encourage you to spend some time remembering what your Emmaus experience meant and what you had planned to do about it. The purpose of Emmaus Ministries is to strengthen the Christian community and develop Christian disciples who will give their lives to sharing Christ. We all have a part to play in God's amazing plan.

How did you enjoy the Easter break? As I write this the gentle rain continues to fall and it seems that my plants are growing by the centimetre overnight.

I find it interesting that when the women returned from the tomb to tell the disciples that Jesus was risen, they did not believe the women until they too had seen and come to believe. It's interesting that in our current climate of domestic violence, workplace abuse and rape, women' witness is still not respected.

When John entered the tomb "he saw and believed." Some of us need evidence. Peter was one who when he saw the head bandages folded separately from the other burial linen, then he believed.

In John's version of the resurrection in chapter 20, he uses three different Greek verbs for seeing: the quick glance that takes in the general picture, the eye for the details and the eye of faith. [With Love to the World, April 4th]. The risen Lord is with us but we may be unaware of his presence because we see with a casual glance. We may see some detail but miss the deeper revelation that comes from the eye of faith.

If our faith only on the evidence we see or the assent of our minds, we may miss the deeper dimensions of our faith that only the heart can appreciate.

Lord open the eyes of our hearts, that we might see you and believe. Thank you for your life poured out for us on the cross, for laying down your life so that we might be restored to you as children of God. Thank you that you rose again and live forever in the hearts of those who believe. Lord we believe. Please nurture our faith so that we grow closer to you and walk more carefully in your footsteps. Amen.
