The Gospel of John tells us that Simon the Fisherman became Peter the Rock. In Genesis 17 we see God changing Abram's name to become Abraham. The reality is the Bible is filled with people who have their identity changed when they have an encounter with God or Jesus.

The disciples were constantly being challenged by Jesus asking them to reflect on what had just happened, how they might act in the future, as Jesus was training them for a ministry that was going to last long beyond his few years on earth.

Sunday's lectionary reading showed us how Jesus explained to Peter that his time on earth was limited and how he was following God's plan. Even though Peter didn't get it right all the time Jesus had a job for him and as we know Peter was the rock that the church would be built upon.

We know that Emmaus walks and Chrysalis Flights can be life changing as people have their own personal encounter with God. The challenge for many though is what to do with this new relationship with God, this new space I find myself in after Emmaus.

For some they find their way onto a conference room team, others find themselves making agape gifts, others find a place in the dining room and many find themselves praying for the walks as part of the 72 hour prayer vigil.

Just as Jesus touched many lives with his physical presence, so too has Emmaus and like Jesus it needs a team of people to make it happen. Reflections - Fourth Day

As I sit at my kitchen table, hearing the Flying Doctor planes go overhead I am reminded that I am now living in Charleville, Qld. A long way from Gympie but nevertheless a place that God has called me to and a place that feels so familiar it's already home.

My fourth day turned out quite different to what I imagined. When I had the privilege of journeying with so many of you during walk 106, I believed my path ahead lay in Bamaga, Cape York. I had gone for a position with the Indigenous council and had got it. But God had other plans, plans that would for fill a lifelong desire to be a Bush Chaplain with Frontier Services.

So long story short, after a sister forwarded me a link to a role working in the Cunnamulla, Burke & Wills Patrol, I had to give it a shot. I am not a minister or pastor but when God has His way those things don't matter. All he needed was a child with a heart to serve and follow Him, to take up the Mantle of Safety that Rev John Flynn laid down and pioneered so many years ago. Several interviews later, a trip to Toowoomba, 7 months of waiting, a 6000 word essay and the role was mine.

This meant leaving my family behind but we all knew that this was where God wanted me to be so I was released to go. Other giants of bush chaplains have gone before me and I feel so intimidated reading their stories but I have to trust God that He knows what He is doing in calling me to this posting.

I head out tomorrow with a team to Birdsville Races, my first official role, it's a ten hour drive that we will do in two days. All I know is there is plenty of flies, truckloads of dust and heaps of yarns. There is a AIM Hospital there, no longer in use but an important part of the inland history.

I have only been in Charleville 4 days but have unpacked, (they gave me a house), spent Saturday volunteering for the Local Chaplaincy Committee in the kitchen at an Arts Festival, been out for dinner to the RSL with some locals and preached at church. Not bad for four days? Can't wait to see what's next! My area is some 450,000 sq km, in easier terms, it takes 10 hours to drive across it and 8 hours to go north to south. Phew...I am already exhausted!!

I am sad that I won't be seeing you all on the Walk to Emmaus in the future but maybe they will release me to join a Walk in Toowoomba - strangely enough the very place I did my walk in 2002. You could come visit me in the "Ville". I have plenty of beds and my door is always open. No doubt I will find something for you to do so just drop me a line and we will make a plan. You can contact me at jennie.f@frontierservices.org or my number 0400800824. Leave me a message as there will be loads of times when I am out of coverage.

So, there is my fourth day. I have been honoured to be a part of your community and the ministry team. I will miss you but who knows when we will meet again. Until then, Yours in Christ.
