Hello everyone

Well, it has been a few years since our Brisbane North Coast Community has hosted a Face to Face Encounter. During 2018 & 2019 our Community hosted 3 Encounters one of which was the first in Australia. All eyes across the world were on the outcome and this was positive; Gold Coast has hosted 1 with another in the planning; Brisbane West has hosted 1 with another in the planning; Brisbane South has hosted 3 with another in the planning; Melbourne hosted 1 in an attempt to save their Community however, though this Community went on for another year it has now closed; South Australia has hosted 3 with I believe another in the planning.

Some of you might say 'What is Face to Face'?

Here are a few highlights!

There are 14 talks ...

Priority Talk is shorter at around 10 minutes and the last talk is a combined Perseverance and Fourth Day Talk given by the Lay Director.

There are still 5 Grace Talks given by the Clergy and Talk 7 "Means of Grace" is followed by a chapel time and "Dying Moments"

There is one main difference with a longer special Talk 13 "Coping in tough times".

There is no Growth through Study Talk

At the end of the first 3 days and after Talk 13 on the last day, a video is shown exploring end-of-life issues. The theme is generally "Living fully, dying well" and these DVDs are meant to be reflective times at the end of the day.

There is still a Candlelighting & a Closing Service both of which involves the broader Emmaus Community.
